June 2022 Monthly Update

Livestock is important to Nebraska's rural economy for a number of reasons. It adds value to locally grown feedstuffs, which means more dollars in the local economy. It provides jobs in working with animals and in all sorts of businesses that buy, sell, or service livestock or livestock facilities. And then there is the investment that creates a tax base. A new 2,400 head swine finishing building will cost around \$900,000, a new dairy farm around \$10,000 per cow, and a new poultry complex will be in the millions.

Earlier this month, the Dundy County Commissioners approved a permit for a new feed yard called Blackshirt Feeders. This new, state-of-the-art facility will see an investment of around \$65 million in rural Dundy County. It will require around 75 employees with an annual payroll of over \$4 million. A lot of those investment dollars will get paid to local contractors who will build the facility. The payroll dollars will stay in the local community like housing, groceries, gas, and other daily living expenses. Plus, the county and school districts will see increases in the tax base to support their schools and local services. The investment in livestock truly is what generates wealth creation for a county.

As AFAN celebrates and enjoys June as Dairy month, we also have a lot of upcoming events. We have our 2nd annual golf tournament in Beemer (June 23), our first-ever Mid-Year update in Grand Island (June 29), and our 2nd annual Nebraska Pork Expo in York (July 20). These events will offer opportunities to have some fun, connect with other folks in agriculture and learn more about what AFAN has been doing this year. We hope to see you at one, or all, of these events!


Looking Ahead
