## **Directors Update**

Nebraska continues to see interest in growth in all livestock sectors, including aquaculture! While interest rates and inflation have slowed things down there is still a lot of groundwork being done for expansion when the time is right.

AFAN has worked on swine, poultry, beef, salmon, and dairy projects this past year....and yes, I did say salmon. These projects range from small egg laying operations to broiler production to milk processing and building new dairy farms. The common denominator is that livestock creates on-farm opportunities for Nebraskans and improves the economy in Nebraska.

Livestock consumes Nebraska feedstuffs, including distiller's grains from ethanol which creates more demand on our corn and soybean resources. This improves the price farmers receive. All the ancillary businesses (feed, veterinary care, medicine, machinery and equipment, fencing and supplies, even plumbers and HVAC folks) see increased demand for what they sell. It all adds up to increased opportunities for all Nebraskans and it gives us a way to attract more people to the state. Livestock; it is what will grow Nebraska.
